DYBA Umpire Job Description

*(this letter is required by the Illinois Department of Labor
for a minor to receive a work permit)*

March 1, 2008

Dear School Administrator:

The Applicant named herein, _____, has applied to the Deerfield Youth Baseball and Softball Association to participate as an umpire. Youth umpires are typically assigned to umpire the younger boys' and girls' games. Games typically last for two hours and it is our preference to schedule 2 umpires per game. The umpires participate in umpire clinics before the season begins in order to learn the rules and mechanics required to be a successful umpire.

Most games during the week last for about 2 hours. Umpires can schedule games on each evening during the week and on Saturday and Sundays. Umpires would typically take only 2-3 games a week and are governed completely by their schedules. No one will be allowed to work more than 6 days a week or work more than 10 games a week.

Umpires call an umpiring scheduler to sign up for games that fit their schedules. In some instances they are asked to work at a last minute in the event that an unforeseen obstacle prevents a previously scheduled umpire from umpiring but they can always refuse the request. *Youth umpires are never forced to work a game; they only work games that fit their schedule.*
